



What is a Community First Responder?

We are specially trained volunteers working with South East Coast Ambulance Service, responding to emergency 999 calls in the local area

(We are not a substitute to the ambulance service, an ambulance is dispatched at the same time)

Why do we exist?

As we are volunteers, we work our shifts in our local community. This means that we can often reach you within minutes and deliver potential life-saving treatment ahead of our colleagues arriving

How are we funded?

As a charity we have to raise money to purchase kit our volunteers use for training and also for attending calls. The one-off cost to get a CFR on the road is around £1,800. The CFRs do not receive any remuneration for the time they are on shift or training

- m This Guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits.
- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit Crowborough Community First Responders will notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request Crowborough Community First Responders to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by Crowborough Community First Responders or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society – if you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when Crowborough Community First Responders asks you to.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify Crowborough Community First Responders.
