Recognising the hours that the team volunteer to respond to emergency 999 calls, the deployment and maintenance of Public Access Defibrillators and running awareness courses in basic life saving skills, such as CPR.

This is the third award that the team has picked up in 2019. Earlier this year the team won the UK HeartSafe Award, and were honoured with the Queen's Award for Voluntary Service.

Crowborough Community First Responders was formed in 2010, became a registered charity in 2014 and was awarded the Queen's Award for Voluntary Service in 2019, the highest award a volunteer group can receive in the UK.

The charity provides specially trained volunteers who work alongside and to respond as directed by South East Coast Ambulance NHS Foundation Trust, to emergency 999 calls in Crowborough and surrounding parishes. The charity is run entirely by its volunteers, 13 in total (8 frontline CFRs and 5 Fundraisers). The Charity's Patron is Mrs Jennifer Tate.
